### **IMPORTANT DATES**

**PRELIMINARY AUDITIONS** - Applications and video links deadline – June 30, 2018

**FINAL ROUND AUDITIONS** – September 22, 2018 at UCLA, Los Angeles

The **preliminary round** is via You Tube video and the **final round** is optionally via in-person or You Tube video.

Winners of the Classics Alive Young Artists Auditions are selected based on exceptional musicianship, technique, ability to communicate as a performer, and future potential. This is to be determined by the judges and all decisions are final.

There will be **5 separate categories** for adjudication. The jury may select a 1st, 2nd, and 3rd prize winner for each category. The categories are: Piano, Strings, Plucked Instruments (guitar, harp, etc.), Winds and Brass, Ensembles.

### **PRIZES**

**1st Prize Winners in each category will receive:**

- \$100 cash prize
- Gold Medal
- Solo performance on **Classics Alive Presents Concert** in Los Angeles
- Membership on the roster of **Classics Alive Young Artists**

**2nd Prize Winners in each category will receive:**

- Silver Medal
- Membership on the roster of Classics Alive Young Artists
- Performance and outreach opportunities

**3rd Prize Winners in each category will receive:**

- Bronze Medal
- Membership on the roster of Classics Alive Young Artists
- Performance and outreach opportunities

**All Finalists will receive:**

- Certificate
- Performance and outreach opportunities
- Evaluator's comment sheets

**All Semi-Finalists will receive:**

- Eligible for the Ambassador Program Community Outreach

**RULES AND PROCEDURES – Young Artists - *Division C* – Ages 10-13**

**ELIGIBILITY** – Young musicians who reside in the United States or who study with a teacher in the United States and who are ages 10-13 as of June 30, 2018 are eligible. Applicants cannot be under U.S. management, but may have management abroad. Students who have previously won 1st prize or Grand Prize in Division C are not eligible.

**REPERTOIRE FOR THE PRELIMINARY ROUND** – The preliminary round will be *video* performances only. Video performances should be uploaded to You Tube and should include 2 contrasting works. **Each work should be a separate You-Tube link.** Each movement of a standard sonata or concerto will be considered one complete work for the purposes of the preliminary auditions.

**ON-LINE APPLICATION PROCEDURES**

Each completed on-line application will include the following:

- A \$55 application fee to *Classics Alive Foundation*

All **finalists** should be prepared to provide a proof of age document (i.e., birth certificate).

**FINAL ROUND** – Finalists will be selected based on the preliminary round video performance submitted with the application. Repertoire for the Final Round does not need to be the same repertoire as submitted for the preliminary round. Repertoire for the Final Round should include 1 solo work. Concerto movements will be allowed for the Final Round. Each movement of a standard sonata or concerto will be considered one complete work for the purposes of the Final Auditions.

Contestants may compete in the final round in-person or via You Tube video. For in-person auditions the Final Round will be held at UCLA, Los Angeles, September 22, 2018. **Finalists will be responsible for their own travel and lodging expenses and other expenses related to the final auditions.**
